- WHEREAS: October 2018 is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and
- WHEREAS: breast cancer is the most common cancer among women, except for skin cancers and the chance of developing breast cancer at some time in a woman's life is 1 in 8; and
- WHEREAS: over 266,000 new cases of invasive breast cancer are expected to occur among women in the United States during 2018; and
- WHEREAS: over 2,500 new cases of breast cancer are expected to occur among men in the United States during 2018; and
- WHEREAS: Susan G. Komen® has set a goal to reduce the current number of breast cancer deaths in the United States by 50% by the year 2026; and
- WHEREAS: this evening, October 4, 2018, we gather in front of the Vigo County Courthouse, where four pink ribbons are illuminated on the dome to honor those who have battled and continue to battle breast cancer.
