## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 11, 2010 As Amended

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 8-34, SPECIFIC MAXIMUM SPEEDS ESTABLISHED – SCHEDULE J OF THE TERRE HAUTE CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, I.C. § 9-21-5-6(a) provides that whenever a local authority determines that the established maximum permitted speed is greater than reasonable and safe, the local authority may determine and declare a reasonable and safe maximum speed limit; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's Office has performed an engineering and traffic investigation; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute wishes to reduce the maximum speed limit of 30 MPH on Bogart Drive, Hamilton Drive, and Nitsche Drive.

SECTION 1. The *Terre Haute City Code*, Chapter 8, Article 1, Section 8-34, Specific Maximum Speeds Established – Schedule J, is hereby amended by inserting the following text:
