A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute through its Rules and Regulations, Section VII, may amend its Rules and Regulations from time to time with a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council wishes to amend its Rules and Regulations;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute that the Rules and Regulations of the Terre Haute Common Council 1990, as most recently revised in 2006, be amended by inserting the underlined text as follows:

SECTION I. The Body of the Council

H. A meeting (also known as the "Sunshine Session") will be conducted one (1) week preceding the Council's regular business meeting, or at times designated by the Council, to discuss, but not vote on, any ordinances or designated resolutions to be acted upon at its next regular meeting. No other matters may be brought up or discussed at this meeting except for ordinances or designated resolutions to be considered at the next regular meeting as specified on the Sunshine Meeting's agenda. All resolutions, except resolutions transferring monies within departmental accounts, shall be listed on the Sunshine Meeting agenda

Except for resolutions to be introduced at a special meeting, all resolutions shall be filed

with the Clerk's Office before 3:00 p.m. on the <u>Friday prior to the</u> Sunshine Meeting date preceding the regular meeting at which the resolution will be acted on. All resolutions shall be
