The proposed Vacation of the Alley would not make access To any land by any person by means of a public way more difficult or inconvenient nor would It hinder any member of the public's access to a church, school or other public building or place nor will it interfere with the provision of utility service.

Wherefore, Petitioners respectfully request and petitions the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, after hearing on this Petition in accordance with law to:

- Adopt an Ordinance Vacating that portion of the Public Alley referred to and
 Described above, subject to existing easement rights for public Utilities.
- b. Cause the Clerk of the City of Terre Haute to furnish copies of said Vacation Ordinance to the County Recorder of Vigo County for recording and to the County Auditor, and to thereupon cause the Recorder to release said Ordinance to the Vigo County Area Planning Department for distribution in accordance with the City's Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Code.
- c. For all other proper relief in the premises.


