  - a. Sandy Mutchler and Chris Aimonio of Crossroads of America Youth Orchestra presented a report for the organization.
  - b. Chief Jeff Fisher announced Fallen Hero Day is Sunday, June 12, 2011. Chief Fisher also asked the Council to consider restricting parking on Ohio Street between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 9 ½ Street to Fire Department employees only.

  - d. Councilman Norm Loudermilk asked Cliff Lambert to inquire if Thompson Thrift might have parking available for Fire Department Employees.
  - e. Vicki Curts stated a police officer shot a dog twice and killed it in response to a complaint about stray dogs in a particular neighborhood. Ms. Curts asked if the police officers could call the Ordinance Enforcers prior to shooting any animals.
