SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 36, 2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 30, 2011, SETTING THE SALARIES AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN BENEFITS FOR THE TRANSIT UTILITY HOURLY WORKERS FOR THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA, FOR 2012, TO TAKE EFFECT ON JANUARY 1, 2012.

WHEREAS, Special Ordinance No. 30, 2011, setting the salaries and benefits for Transit Utility workers was passed by the City Council on September 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, negotiation of the transit contract was not completed and the contract executed by the Board of Public Works and Safety until February 9, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the negotiated contract provided for a one percent (1%) raise to be effective on January 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Special Ordinance No. 30, 2011, did not provide any raise in wages for calendar year 2012 over 2011 hourly wages and the ordinance must be amended to provide for the contractually agreed upon 2012 wages.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana that Special Ordinance No. 30, 2011, is amended by deletion of the stricken text and insertion of the underlined text as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 2012, the following salary schedule shall be in full force and effect for the Transit Utility Hourly Workers of the City of Terre Haute as follows:

* Bus Operator	\$ 16.95 <u>17.12</u> per hour
Mechanics	\$ 17.78 <u>17.95</u> per hour
** Cleaners and Utility Men	\$ 17.00 <u>17.17</u> per hour
Part-Time Employees	\$ 14.49 <u>14.63</u> per hour
All New Hires	\$ 12.02 <u>12.14</u> per hour for first ninety (90) days
	Full pay after first ninety (90) days

* Motor coach operators shall be allowed One Dollar (\$1) per hour additional pay for such time as they are engaged in instructing student drivers.

** Full-time second shift Operators, Mechanics & Utility Men shall be paid Five Cents (.05) more per hour.

Full-time third shift Operators, Mechanics, and Utility Men shall be paid Ten Cents

(.10) more per hour.

SECTION 2. The illegality or invalidity, for any reason, of any of the sections of this ordinance, or parts thereof, shall invalidate only such section or sections as are so determined to be illegal or invalid, and any such invalidity shall have no effect on the remaining sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 3 All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be effective as in the salaries provided on and for January 1, 2012.
