AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 37, 2011, SETTING THE SALARIES AND BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute:

SECTION 1. Special Ordinance No. 37, 2011, passed by the City Council on September 14, 2011, is hereby amended by deletion of the stricken text and insertion of the underlined text as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 2012, the following salary schedule shall be in full force and effect for the designated Municipal Employees of the City of Terre Haute by Department, as follows:

SECTION 2. Commencing January 1, 2012, the City of Terre Haute will provide to each full time, permanent employee whose salary is established by this ordinance health and hospitalization insurance coverage through December 31, 2012. The City will pay seventy percent (70%) of the actual monthly premium.

The payment of the sums contemplated herein to be paid by the employee shall be by means of payroll deduction, through the Office of the City Controller of the City of Terre Haute, as insurance premiums are presently deducted in such office.

SECTION 3. Commencing January 1, 2012, the City of Terre Haute will provide to each department head and full time, permanent employee whose salary is established by this ordinance dental insurance coverage through December 31, 2012. The City will pay seventy percent (70%) of the actual monthly premium.

SECTION 10. Commencing January 1, 2012, the City of Terre Haute will provide to each benefit eligible employee, whose salary is established by this ordinance, Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) of life insurance coverage through December 31, 2012. The City will pay one hundred percent (100%) of the costs of such coverages.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be effective as in the salaries provided on and for January 1, 2012.
