AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 29, 2012 – TO AMEND THE SALARIES FOR THE MVH (STREET DEPARTMENT) HOURLY WORKERS FOR THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA, FOR 2013, TO TAKE EFFECT ON JANUARY 1, 2013.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement between the City of Terre Haute, by and through its Board of Public Works and Safety, ("City") and Laborer's International Union of North America – State of Indiana District Council Local Union #204 ("Union"), effective January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013, contains a "wage reopener clause" for wages payable in 2013.

SECTION 2. Negotiation of the Street Department 2013 wages occurred after the passage deadlines for salary ordinances and Special Ordinance No. 29, 2012 was introduced and passed contemplating a 2% wage increase for 2013 for all Street Department job classifications.

SECTION 3. The Street Department employees have negotiated a 2013 wage increase whereby the total budget available of a 2% increase for wages increases is to be distributed equally among all job classifications.

SECTION 4. Therefore, Special Ordinance No. 29, 2012, is hereby amended by deletion of the stricken text and insertion of the deleted text to reflect the negotiated agreement between the City and the Union representing an equal distribution of wage increases for all Street Department job classifications effective in calendar year 2013:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Commencing January 1, 2013, the following salary schedule shall be in full force and effect for MVH (Street Department) of the City of Terre Haute as follows:

Lead Foreman	\$ 20.97 <u>20.89</u> per hour
Office Manager	\$ 14.86 <u>14.90</u> per hour
Secretary	\$ 14.36
Working Foreman	\$ 17.28
Mechanic Foreman	\$ 17.40
Mechanic - First Class	\$ 17.14
Street Maintenance Worker #1	\$ 16.11 <u>16.12</u> per hour
Street Maintenance Worker #2	\$ 15.69

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be effective as in the salaries provided on and for January 1, 2013.
