SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 9, 2013

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PLATTED PUBLIC ALLEY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, VIGO COUNTY, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDERED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12, it is desired and deemed necessary to vacate a portion of a platted public alley located in the City of Terre Haute, Vigo County, Indiana, which is platted in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, and described as follows:

An alley running east and west between the City of Terre Haute Department of Parks and Recreation trail and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14 of Spang and Grubes Subdivision bounded by 22nd Street on the West and 23rd Street on the East.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that said alley in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, above described, be and the same is vacated and will revert in its entirety to the abutting property owners to the South, subject to the continuation of any and all existing easement rights for public utilities.

SECTION 3. Be it further ordained that the City Clerk be, and is hereby directed to furnish a copy of this Ordinance to the Recorder of Vigo County, Indiana, for recording, and to the Auditor of Vigo County, Indiana.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after it passage by the Common Council of Terre Haute, and its approval by the mayor and publication as by law provided.


