SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2015

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 28, 2014, AS AMENDED BY SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 36, 2014, TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN BENEFITS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA FOR 2015, TO TAKE EFFECT ON JANUARY 1, 2015.

WHEREAS, Special Ordinance No. 28, 2014, As Amended, was passed on October 9, 2014 establishing certain benefits for members of the Terre Haute Police Department for budget year 2015; and

WHEREAS, by Special Ordinance No. 36, 2014, passed on December 11, 2014, Special Ordinance No. 28, 2014 was further amended with regard to Terre Haute Police Department benefits for budget year 2015; and

WHEREAS, two (2) additional pay allowances have been created within the Terre Haute Police Department for budget year 2015 that were not included in the previous salary ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That Special Ordinance No. 28, 2014, As Amended, is hereby further amended by the insertion of the underlined text and deletion of the stricken text as follows:

SECTION 2. City of Terre Haute shall pay an annual cash allowance of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to each uniformed officer to be used for uniforms, clothing, and equipment (excluding body armor). ~~One (1) individual within the Department shall serve as Indiana Data & Communication Service (IDACS) Coordinator and shall receive an annual allowance of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). One (1) individual within the Department shall serve as the Indiana Data & Communication Service (IDACS) Assistant Coordinator and shall receive an annual allowance of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).~~ ~~This~~ These allowances will not be included in the calculation of base pay and will be paid on November 5, 2015.

SECTION 2. The illegality or invalidity, for any reason, of any of the sections of this ordinance, or parts thereof, shall invalidate only such sections or sections as are so determined to be illegal or invalid, any such invalidity shall have no effect on the remaining sections of this ordinance.


SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage according to law and shall be effective as in the salaries and benefits provided on and for January 1, 2015.




