<u>SECTION 1.</u> Pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12, it is desired and deemed necessary to vacate a portion of a Public Alleyway located in the City of Terre Haute, Vigo County, Indiana, which is now laid out and existing in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, and described as follows:



PETITION FOR VACATION OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC ALLEY

TO THE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, VIGO COUNTY, INDIANA

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

Glas-Col, LLC, as the owner of land abutting a certain platted alley, respectfully petitions and requests the legislative body of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, to vacate that portion of the platted alley described below pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12, and in support of this Petition would show to the Common Council of said City as follows:

1. Glas-Col, LLC, Petitioner, is the owner of the following described real estate located in Vigo County, State of Indiana:

Lots Numbers One (1) through Twenty-two (22) in the replat of Lot Number One (1) in Idaho Place, in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, as shown by the recorded plat thereof recorded in Plat Record 14, page 49 in the Recorder's Office of Vigo County, Indiana.

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of South Eighth Street and Hulman Street in the City of Terre Haute, County of Vigo, Indiana; thence West to the West line of Lockport Road between Hulman Street and South Eighth Street as it existed prior to the vacation of that road by Special Ordinance No. 18, 1994 adopted by the Common Council of Terre Haute on the 14th day of April, 1994, thence Southeast along said West line to the western boundary of South Eighth Street; thence North to the place of beginning.

2. A 16-foot wide alley running north-south through the middle of the property owned by Glas-Col, LLC, and said alley, beginning at the southern line of Hulman Street and extends south to the northern line of the Idaho street right of way, is bounded as follows:

On the east, by Lots Numbers Seventeen (17) through Twenty-two (22) in the replat of Lot Number One (1) in Idaho Place, in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, as shown by the recorded plat thereof recorded in Plat Record 14, page 49 in the Recorder's

On the west, by Lots Numbers One (1) through Sixteen (16) in the replat of Lot Number One (1) in Idaho Place, in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, as shown by the recorded plat thereof recorded in Plat Record 14, page 49 in the Recorder's Office of Vigo County, Indiana.

The attached site plan highlights in yellow that portion of the public alley, as described above, which Petitioner seeks to have vacated. Petitioner is the owner of all of abutting property on both sides of that portion of the alley to be vacated.

- 3. No other landowner adjoins and abuts that portion of the public alley to be vacated, so no landowners would be adversely affected by the vacation of the same.
 - 4. Petitioner proposes the vacation of that portion of the public alley because:
 - Petitioner conducts its business of Glas-Col, LLC on the property and owns all of the property on the block that the alley runs through. There are several buildings used in the business on the block and employees must cross the public alley traveling to and from the respective buildings which at times creates a hazardous situation. A couple of the buildings have doors that open onto the alleyway from which employees step out into the alley. Any traffic travelling through the alley is at risk of striking persons walking out of the doorway. The alley is not heavily travelled by vehicles, but those that do create a hazard.
 - The alley is not used for any designated public service purpose.
 - There are open public streets, 7th Street and 8th Street, each running north and south, which allow public travel on both the east and west sides of the block at issue.
 - 5. The proposed vacation would not hinder the use of any other public alley; and as set forth above, the proposed vacation would not make access to any land by any person by means of a public way difficult or inconvenient; nor would said vacation hinder any member of the public's access to a church, school or other public building or place.
 - 6. The name and address of the only owner of land that abuts that portion of said alley proposed to be vacated is:

Glas-Col, LLC 711 Hulman St. Terre Haute, IN 47802 WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests and petitions the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, after hearing on this Petition in accordance with law, to:

- A) Adopt an Ordinance vacating that portion of the public alley referred to and described above;
- B) Cause the Clerk of the City of Terre Haute to furnish copies of said Vacation Ordinance to the County Recorder of Vigo County for recording and to the County Auditor, and to thereupon cause the Recorder to release said Ordinance to the Vigo County Area Planning Department for distribution in accordance with paragraph 1125.06 of the City's Zoning Ordinance; and
- C) For all other proper relief in the premises.


