The transfer from Diesel Fuel and Purchase of Equipment was made necessary to cover a deficit created by two serious accidents that are still being covered by Worker's Comp. One accident happened in October of 2014 and the other in February of 2016. These two claims are ongoing and created charges that exceeded the budgeted amount for that item.

The transfer from Double Time to Traffic Signal Tech is to make up a deficit in the Traffic Signal Tech line item created by having to hire a Technician to train as a replacement for a Technician that was retiring. For a short period of time two Technicians were employed for one spot.
