- 3. Public Comment on Non-Agenda Items
 - a. Garry Morris with Clabber Girl concerning a non-working stoplight at 7th and Cherry and the financial oversight committee.
 - b. Council President Todd Nation asked Chuck Ennis about the stoplight situation.
 - c. Mayor Duke Bennett stated the pole for the stoplight at 7th and Cherry is on order and the City did not have any in stock. Mayor Bennett commented that the members of the selection committee for the financial oversight committee are not being made public. Mayor Bennett commented the Park Board made the decision on the pools without his knowledge and they would be reviewing it at the next meeting. He also commented on a committee formed to review the fate of the golf courses. Mayor Bennett commented that the EDIT surplus funds would be used for the Margaret expansion project. He stated that a proposed amendment to the welluser sewer fee is being worked on. Mayor Bennett stated the pool's repair would costs between \$25,000 and \$30,000. He also stated the golf courses looses \$400,000 annually. Mayor Bennett commented on the golf course committee membership and its members. He responded to questions about the City's financial consultant with the reply of Umbaugh and Associates as well as other companies. Mayor Bennett explained that if Councilman Elliott contacted the financial consultants directly the City would be charged for that service. He commented the funds received from the Rae Park tree settlement was placed in a special Non-Reverting fund that the Council created. Mayor Bennett also stated the fund was used for various projects for the golf courses. Mayor Bennett commented the financial oversight committee would begin in the next thirty days.
 - d. George Amies commented about the City's golf courses, the damage to the trees in Rae Park, the funds recovered from the damaged tree settlement, and closing of Deming Pool.
 - e. Wendy Bennett commented on the need for a City pool and the golf courses could be closed to fund the pool.
 - f. Councilman Don Morris asked for more information concerning the financial oversight committee.
 - g. Councilwoman Martha Crossen asked about the members of the financial oversight committee. She also questioned if the money received from the Rae Park tree settlement was used for replacing the trees.
 - h. Councilman Karrum Nasser asked the Mayor about the pool closure, costs for repairs, who appointed the members to the Park Board, the surplus of the EDIT funds, and spending that surplus on the pools. Councilman Nasser also questioned about a possible amendment to the welluser sewer fee.
 - i. Councilman Curtis Debaun IV asked the amount needed to fix the pool and how much the golf courses loose each year.
 - j. Councilman O. Earl Elliott asked for the names of the members on the golf course committee. Councilman Elliott also asked who the financial consultant for the City is. He asked if he could contact the financial consultants directly. Councilman Elliott also commented on the amount of funds the Parks budget looses annually.
 - k. Council President Todd Nation asked Mayor Bennett to respond to the question asked by the public concerning the Rae Park tree damage settlement. He also asked Mayor Bennett about the start date for the financial oversight committee. Council President Nation stated there would be a special meeting on June 2, 2016 at 5:30pm concerning a presentation by a member of the State Revolving Fund organization. He also stated there would be an additional special meeting on June 2, 2016 at 5:00pm to discuss the financial situation of the City. In addition, there will be a special meeting on June 9, 2016 at 5:15pm concerning tax abatement CF1 forms (at the end of the meeting this time was changed to 5:30pm)
