RESOLUTION NO. 3, 2017

A RESOLUTION URGING THE INDIANA GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND GOVERNOR HOLCOMB TO SUPPORT A FULL HOUSE CASINO/GAMING DESTINATION IN TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA
