

SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SPECIAL ORDINANCE 23 THROUGH 38, 2019 MODIFYING THE DATE OF THE ELECTION DAY HOLIDAY RELATED TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS, an Executive Order from Indiana Governor Holcomb changed the date of the Indiana Primary Election, an observed holiday, makes it necessary to amend the date listed in most Salary Ordinances for City employees; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute:

SECTION 1. Special Ordinance 23-38, 2019, establishing the salaries and additional benefits for City employees shall be amended by the addition of the underlined text and removal of the stricken text as follows:

(D) HOLIDAYS

...

Election Day ~~May 5, 2020~~ June 2, 2020

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and may be applied retroactively, as permitted by law, to January 01, 2020.
