Trees on the prohibited species have one or more characteristic that makes it unsuited for planting in the tree row or on public right of way. Invasive (I) Poisonous (P) Weak wood (W) Messy Fruit (M) Disease (D) Insect (IN) Thorns (T) Otherwise unsuitable (U)

Crataegus phaenopyrum – Washington Hawthorn (T)

Crataegus viridis – Winter King Hawthorn (T)

Fagus spp. – Beech species(U),

Gymnocladus dioica spp. – Kentucky Coffee (P)

Fraxinus spp. – Ash species (IN)

Ginkgo biloba – Female Ginkgo (M, U)

Juglans spp. – Walnut species (M,D)

Koelreuteria paniculata - Golden Raintree (I)

Liquidambar styraciflua spp. – Sweetgum (M)

Maclura pomifera – Hedge Apple (Osage Orange). (I,M)

Morus spp. – Mulberry species (I,M,W)

Phellodendron amurense, - Amur cork tree (I)

Picea, Pinus, Abies sp. – Needle evergreens (U)

Populus spp. – Cottonwood species (W,U)

Pyrus spp. – Pear species (W, M, U)

Robinia pseudoacacia – Black Locust (T , I)

Quercus acutissima, Sawtooth Oak (I)

Salix sp. – Willow species (W,U)

Sassafras albidum – Sassafras (U)

Sophora japonica – Japanese Pagodatree (M,W)

Tilia sp. – Linden species (IN, W, U)

Ulmus americana – American Elm (W,D)

Ulmus pumila – Siberian Elm (E,D)
