Position Responsibilities (include but are not limited to the following):

- Maintain vehicles and equipment by routine maintenance (oil changes, grease chassis, check and adjust brakes, tune-ups, carburetion and replacing of various filters)
- Schedule preventative maintenance with Police and WWTP departments
- ECM computer skills
- Electrical repair ability
- Fuel injection diagnostics
- Brakes, steering, air conditioning and suspension knowledge
- Able to use machinery such as brake lathes, tire repair and balancer, welding equipment
- Keep shop area clean and orderly

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required:

- Considerable ability to work well with others
- Working ability to solve technical problems
- Experience with braking systems, hydraulics, power take off units & suspensions
- Familiar with common powered and non-powered tools (saw, wrench, drill)
- Familiarity of diesel engines and automotive electrical systems

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- At least 3 years of mechanical experience in the automotive and or heavy equipment field
- Computer diagnostic and testing ability
- ASE certifications, factory trained certifications or equivalent state certifications desired
- Physical and drug screen is required before hiring
- All applicants must be authorized to work in the USA
- Valid driver's license
- CDL license must be obtained before or within the first 90 days of employment
- Equivalent combination of relevant education and or experience will also be considered

Working Conditions:

• Indoor and outdoor environments, including extreme heat and extreme cold, automotive repair facility

Physical Requirements:

- Sufficient physical ability to perform all maintenance tasks
- Ability to see within normal parameters
- Ability to hear within normal range
- Able to carry weight up to 50lbs
- Manual dexterity in hands and legs to use tools, bend and stretch
- Able to climb ladders and steps repeatedly throughout assigned shift
