every dollar in final sales of manufacturing goods adds \$1.48 in economic output

from other sectors of the economy; and

and processes to remain the most productive in the world; and

WHEREAS: Advanced Manufacturing continued prosperity depends on the promotion of

educational and vocational opportunities that align workforce and economic

development resources with employment opportunities; and

fueling economic growth and building a promising future for our City.
