WHEREAS: Indiana's agribusiness employs 40,000 year-round, seasonal, and migrant farm

workers, who are key partners for the safety, security and sustainability of our

food supply; and

WHEREAS: the labor of Indiana's farm workers contributes billions of dollars annually to

the state's economy and agriculture continues to be one of the principal

industries in the state; and

WHEREAS: the National Farm Worker Jobs Program provides funding to Proteus, Inc. to

assist migrant and seasonal farm workers and their dependents attain greater

economic stability; and

WHEREAS: the program partners with community organizations and state agencies to

counter chronic unemployment and underemployment experienced by farm workers who depend primarily on agricultural labor performed across the

country; and

WHEREAS: March 31 is the birthday of Cesar Chavez, whose dedication to nonviolent

organizing for wages, safe labor conditions, and dignity for women, men, and

children who toil in the fields, moved him to lead a nationwide, peaceful

struggle for farm worker justice that continues today.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim the week of March 24-March 30, 2019 as
