



PROCLAMATION

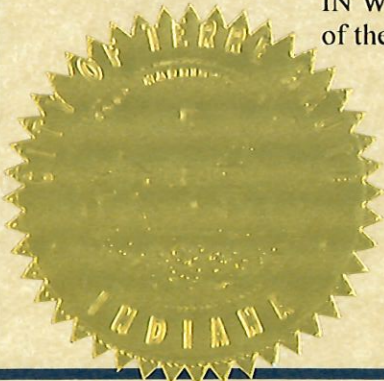
- WHEREAS: correctional officers and employees are capable, committed, patient and persistent professionals; and
