U.S.; nearly 70% of these are fatalities caused by drowning; and

WHEREAS: the vast majority of these accidents are caused by human error or poor

judgment and not by the boat, equipment, or environmental factors; and

WHEREAS: a significant number of boaters who lose their lives by drowning each year

would be alive today had they worn their life jackets; and

WHEREAS: modern life jackets are more comfortable, more attractive, and more

wearable than styles of years past and deserve a fresh look by today's

boating public.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, Duke A Bennett, Mayor of the City of Terre Haute, do hereby proclaim May 18-24, 2019 as

NATIONAL SAFE BOATING WEEK

in Terre Haute, and the start of the year-round effort to promote safe boating. I urge all those who boat to "Boat Smart. Boat Safe. Wear It." and practice safe boating habits.
